The Hemet Concert Association (HCA) announces, with deepest regrets, that the 2020-21 season has been canceled. In our 48 years of presenting world-class concerts, this is a sad first.

This cancellation is necessary and appropriate so we can comply with current and likely continuing state and county COVID-19 directives. In addition, the Hemet Unified School District could not assure us that the Tahquitz Performing Arts Center would be available for January through April concerts because of COVID-19 and there is no other adequate local venue available elsewhere.

We have contacted this season's scheduled artists to see if they would be available for HCA's 2021-22 season. The good news is that most have responded favorably.

We hope you will agree with us to view this "un-season" as a period of "hibernation." Be assured that the HCA has plans to provide a robust 2021-2022 concert season! During our "hibernation" we promise to keep in touch with each of you. We plan to present to you opportunities to enjoy some virtual concerts and music via your computer and/or cell phone. Details will be forthcoming.
